808.1. OTHER FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	
1. Purpose	<p>The school district provides services and materials to students to help enhance their educational experience. There are also activities which students can participate in that provide the opportunity to make education more meaningful and exciting. To help maintain these programs it is important for students to properly maintain the materials given to them. Failure to do so will impede the district's ability to provide the best education possible. Similarly, school sponsored activities will often conduct fund raisers to help support their related activity. It is expected that if a child participates in a fund raising activity that it is done with fidelity.</p> <p>It is the parent's (guardian's) responsibility to replace any damaged materials. Additionally, if a child chooses to participate in a fund raiser, all unsold products must be returned to the advisor as well as all funds that were collected.</p>
2. Authority	<p>The Board shall have the authority to bill parents for financial obligations related to functions that occur within the school district. Unless other arrangements have been made through the proper authority at the school district, the Superintendent or designee shall have the authority to seek alternative payment methods.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent and/or his designee will develop procedures for notifying and collecting funds owed to the school district. The procedures will be outlined in the 808.1 Administrative Regulation.</p> <p>Outside organizations such as PTO and Boosters, refer to Policy 915.</p>
